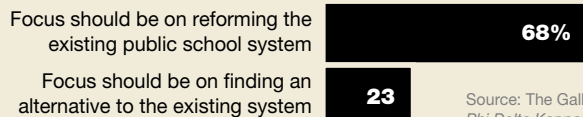


## Alternate Schooling

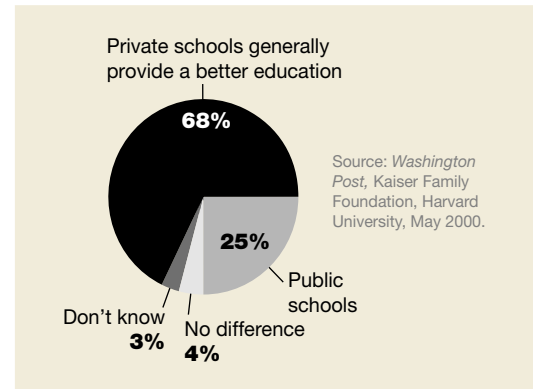
Though they aren't ready to give up on the public school system, most Americans believe private schools provide a better education. About six in ten parents with school-age children send them to public schools, but around 40 percent are going outside the system. Most of those use private schools. But 8 percent of U.S. parents are homeschooling their children or have in the past, and another third know someone who does. The top reasons: dissatisfaction with academic instruction or a desire to provide religious or moral instruction.

Question: In order to improve public education in America, some people think...



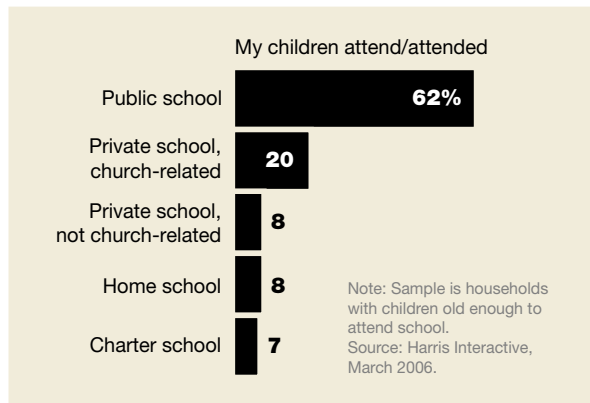

Question: In thinking about schools nationally, which do you think...?

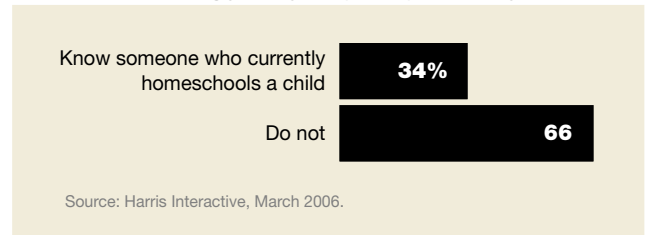

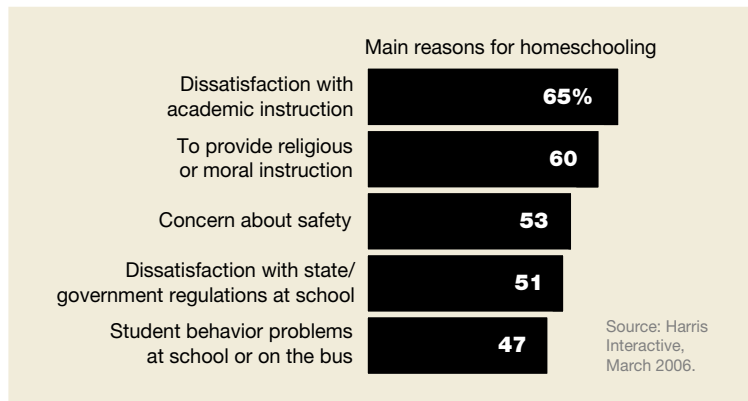
Question: What types of schools...?



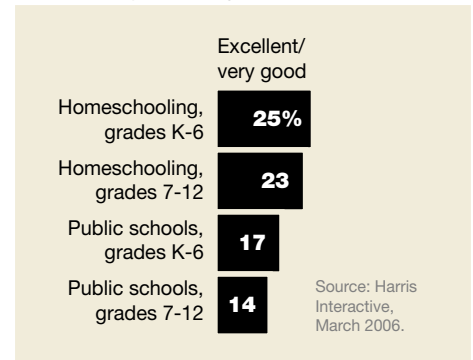
Question: Not including you or your spouse/partner, do you...?



Question: Why is/was your child homeschooled?



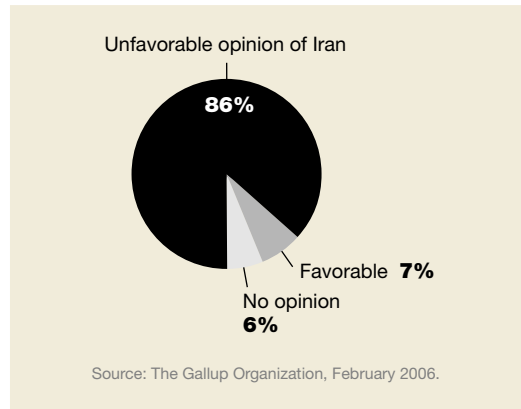
Question: Overall, how would you rate the quality of education provided by...?



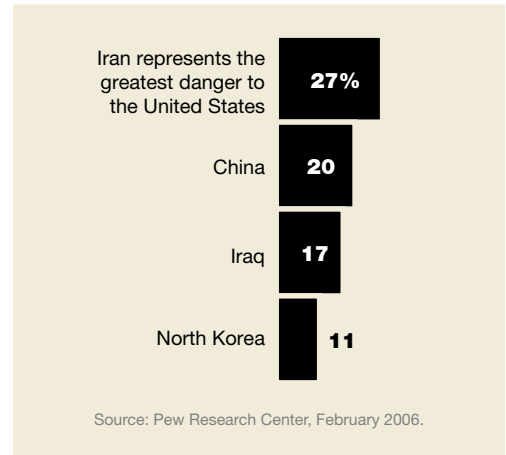
# Terror From Tehran

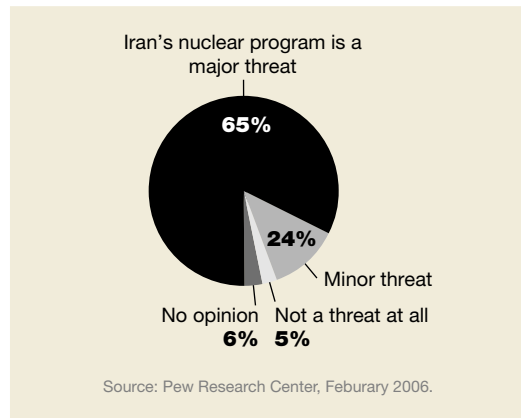
Question: Now I'd like your overall opinion of some foreign countries. Is your overall opinion of...?



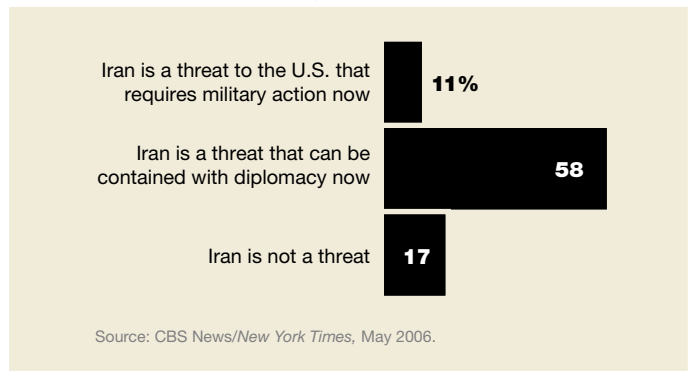
Question: Which country, if any,...
